Sub: Settlement of Family Pension under CMPS 98.

Dear Sir,

We would like to bring to your kind notice the difficulties being faced by the spouses of retired employees of Coal India Limited for settlement of family pensions in case of death of retired employees.

In the case of death of a retired employee / pension holder, the spouse is required to visit the place of last posting of the retired employee to initiate the process of claim of family pension. This system is causing a lot of difficulties to the surviving spouse, due to, largely having settled at a far off place after superannuation, and also due to ageing in many cases. It is brought to our notice that in a number of cases, the last place of posting of such retired employee is no longer in operation now and it is difficult to trace the required records...

As per present practice, an employee needs to submit Adhaar Number for self and spouse and the Bank Account details for receipt of pension, opened duly with the mode of operation as "Former or Survivor". With these facilities available with CMPFO and the pension disbursing Banks, it would be proper to simplify the process of disbursal of "Family Pension" and do away with the requirement of presenting the surviving spouse at the last place of posting for start of the Family Pension. It is therefore suggested that production of "Death Certificate" of the retired employee to the CMPFO and the Pension disbursing Bank should be accepted for start of the "Family Pension" to the dependent spouse.
